

University Psychology Clinic Services

This Resource Guide includes information about the services, costs and waitlists for those universities in NSW that offer student-run psychology clinics. SPELD NSW has collated this information from the various university clinics for use by parents seeking to access these services. We are not able to recommend individual clinics as we have not examined the quality of assessments and other services provided by these clinics.

At university psychology clinics, assessments are generally undertaken by provisionally registered and fully registered psychologists who are currently undertaking postgraduate study. They are generally supervised by Clinical Psychologists or Neuropsychologists who have experience and registered psychologists.
