

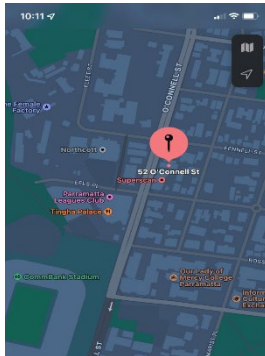
SPELD NSW Assessments

What will happen during the assessment?

The person being assessed will participate in assessments with the SPELD NSW Clinic Team. It takes approximately 2-4 hours to complete (depending on the assessment type) and involves answering questions, writing tasks, problem solving activities, and completing puzzles. The clinic team will also use information gathered from the assessment to develop recommendations to help them.
